Course Name and Course Code	Course Description	Duration
Job Hazard Analysis for Supervisors – <b>SH23</b>	Developed for supervisors, this course covers safe work practices, including the job hazard analysis (JHA), its methods, and steps according to Cal/OSHA regulations. It also covers hazard assessment tools used in identifying workplace hazards.	60 min
Ladder Safety – <b>SG16</b>	Learn the basics of ladder safety. You'll find out how to select the appropriate ladder for the job, inspect and maintain ladders, check for safety hazards, follow safe climbing procedures, and identify the purpose of safety systems and devices.	25 min
Accident Incident Investigation Cal/OSHA – <b>SG12</b>	This course covers a four-step investigation process that you can use as part of your Cal/OSHA Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP). Define accidents, incidents, root causes, and close calls and learn how to follow all four steps to make your workplace safe and prevent further incidents.	30 min
Injury and Illness Prevention Programs – Your Roadmap to Safety – <b>SFIP</b>	Injury and Illness Prevention Programs are required by Cal/OSHA for all California businesses with at least one employee. This requirement is also regularly the most-frequently cited Cal/OSHA standard. Learn what an Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP) is and how they benefit businesses. Each of the required elements of an IIPP and their importance for safety will be covered as well as tips to effectively implement your IIPP.	60 min
State Fund's Fall Prevention Course – <b>SFFP21</b>	Falls are the leading cause of death in the construction industry. Learn about common fall hazards at construction sites and methods of keeping employees safe from fall hazards.	60 min
State Fund's Scaffold Safety Course – <b>SFSS</b>	Though scaffolds provide safety for work at elevated heights, they can be dangerous if they are not erected properly or if workers are not properly trained on how to use them. Learn about Cal/OSHA requirements for scaffolds and how to recognize unsafe scaffolds in this course created by State Fund.	40 min

In addition to the Learning Plan above, STAR participants will learn about recognizing and addressing fall hazards at job sites. Effective implementation of Injury and Illness Prevention Programs (IIPPs) will also be covered with an emphasis on how an effective IIPP can help prevent fall injuries and fatalities. Students will be introduced to a variety of online resources and tools to help prevent fall injuries. These workshops will be interactive with plenty of group discussion and activities.
